Illinois Phases

Illinois Phase 5 - “NORMAL” Traditional In-Person Rehearsal Schedule & Performances

Illinois Phase 4 - OUTDOOR/INDOOR SMALL GROUPS

Gatherings: Gatherings of 50 people or fewer are allowed with this limit subject to change based on latest data and guidance

Education and child care: P-12 schools, higher education, all summer programs, and child care open with IDPH approved safety guidance

Theater/Performing Arts Industry Guidelines: Indoor audiences at 50% or 50, whichever lower. Outdoor at 20% of capacity (probably referencing large stadiums).

Illinois Phase 3 (Tier 3 Resurgence Mitigations) - OUTDOOR SMALL GROUPS

Gatherings: No indoor gatherings. Outdoor gatherings of 10 people with social distancing allowed.

Education and child care: Remote learning in P-12 schools and higher education.

Illinois Phase 2 - ALL VIRTUAL

Gatherings: Essential gatherings, such as religious services, of 10 or fewer allowed; No non-essential gatherings

Education and child care: Remote learning in P-12 schools and higher education; Child care in groups of 10 or fewer for essential workers
Outdoor recreation: Walking, hiking, and biking

Illinois Phase 1-- ALL VIRTUAL

Gatherings: Essential gatherings, such as religious services, of 10 or fewer allowed; No non-essential gatherings of any size

Education and child care: Remote learning in P-12 schools and higher education; Child care in groups of 10 or fewer for essential workers
