PUFFS CHARACTER DESCRIPTIONS

WAYNE HOPKINS- (Male Presenting) The hero, and a complete dork. He is constantly worried that his life won't amount to anything, and wants to get the most points possible for The Puffs. Best friends with Oliver and Megan.

OLIVER RIVERS- (Male Presenting) A math genius from New Jersey. He has never done magic, and thus has never been bad at school before now. Best friends with Wayne and love interest for Megan.

MEGAN JONES- (Female Presenting) Daughter of a Death Buddy, Megan Jones wants nothing more than to be a snake, but to her dismay is sorted into the Puffs. She goes through a lot of transformation from year to year as she finds herself and begins to date Oliver.

NARRATOR- (Non-Gender Specific, British Accent) The story-teller. They will be on-stage the whole show and need a big personality as well as strong comedic ability.

ERNIE MAC AND OTHERS- (Male Presenting, British Accent) This track plays most of the professors throughout the story. Ernie Mac is a typical dude-bro and is the character played the most often by this actor. Requires strong improvisation and impressions.

HANNAH AND OTHERS- (Female Presenting, British Accent) Hannah gets made fun of. A lot. That's really the most important thing about her. Her track consists of most of the female professors in the show, and the actor will need to be able to switch between them quickly and efficiently. Strong character choices are the biggest asset to the actor in this role.

J. FINCH FLETCHLEY AND OTHERS- (Male Presenting, British Accent, German/Hungarian/Russia/Etc. Accent) J. Finch is boyish and fun and most importantly, loves being J. Finch. Strong improvisational skills are necessary for all roles in this track.

LEANNE, GINNY, AND OTHERS- (Female Presenting, British Accent, French Accent) Very silly and loves doing magic. This track plays the majority of the female love interest roles. Lots of pride for the Puffs in this whole track.

SALLY PERKS AND OTHERS- (Female Presenting, British Accent) Sally attracts the attention of Wayne throughout the show. Other characters in the track require lots of energy, and lots of personality.

SUSIE BONES, HARRY, AND OTHERS- (Female Presenting, British Accent) Susie and Harry are both very angry teenagers throughout the show. Track requires strong character choices.

CEDRIC AND MR. VOLDY- (Male Presenting, British Accent) Cedric, in Act 1, is the ideal Puff, and is treated as somewhat of a God. In Act 2, Mr. Voldy is evil, very very evil. Requires large comedic ability and a knack for physical comedy.
